Information for Presenters

Getting There

The conference is at the Australian Defence Force Academy, main entrance off Northcott Drive, Campbell (the road from the back of the Russell offices to the Campbell Park offices, crossing Fairbairn Ave at a roundabout – ADFA sign). *See the map below.* Look for the CMA signs and banners from the front entrance.

Parking

On turning into the front entrance, turn immediately left into Kapyong Road, then down to the bottom of the hill and right into one of the parking bays in Carpark 90 (top of the map).

The conference venue, Building 32, is a short uphill walk from the the carpark.

Walk between the two buildings (Buildings 20 and 21 on the map) with a walkway above, then continue straight ahead. Again look for the CMA banners and signs.

Registration

We don't insist that our presenters register (and pay) for the conference. However, if your organisation will pay for your registration, the money will be put to a good cause, the enhancement of Maths education in the ACT and surrounding areas.

Whether you register or not, you are certainly most welcome to the lunch, morning and afternoon teas, and the President's drinks. We welcome your participation and hope you will talk to the delegates not only as part of your presentation but informally in the breaks.

You may leave any material and equipment under the stairs behind the registration desk before and after your talk.

Informal dinner: Presenters are welcome to attend an informal dinner with CMA Council members at a local restaurant after the President's drinks. Please put your name down at the registration desk.

Presentations

Each room is fitted with a computer with Windows software, internet and USB sockets, projector or multiple TV monitors, document camera, DVD player, lapel and fixed microphones, whiteboards and provision for connecting laptops: HDMI and VGA plugs, PS USB socket in older rooms; HDMI plug, PC USB socket in newer rooms.

Details of individual rooms *Room capacity in brackets*

LT6 (100): tiered lecture theatre, seats with tray tables. Two projectors and two screens.

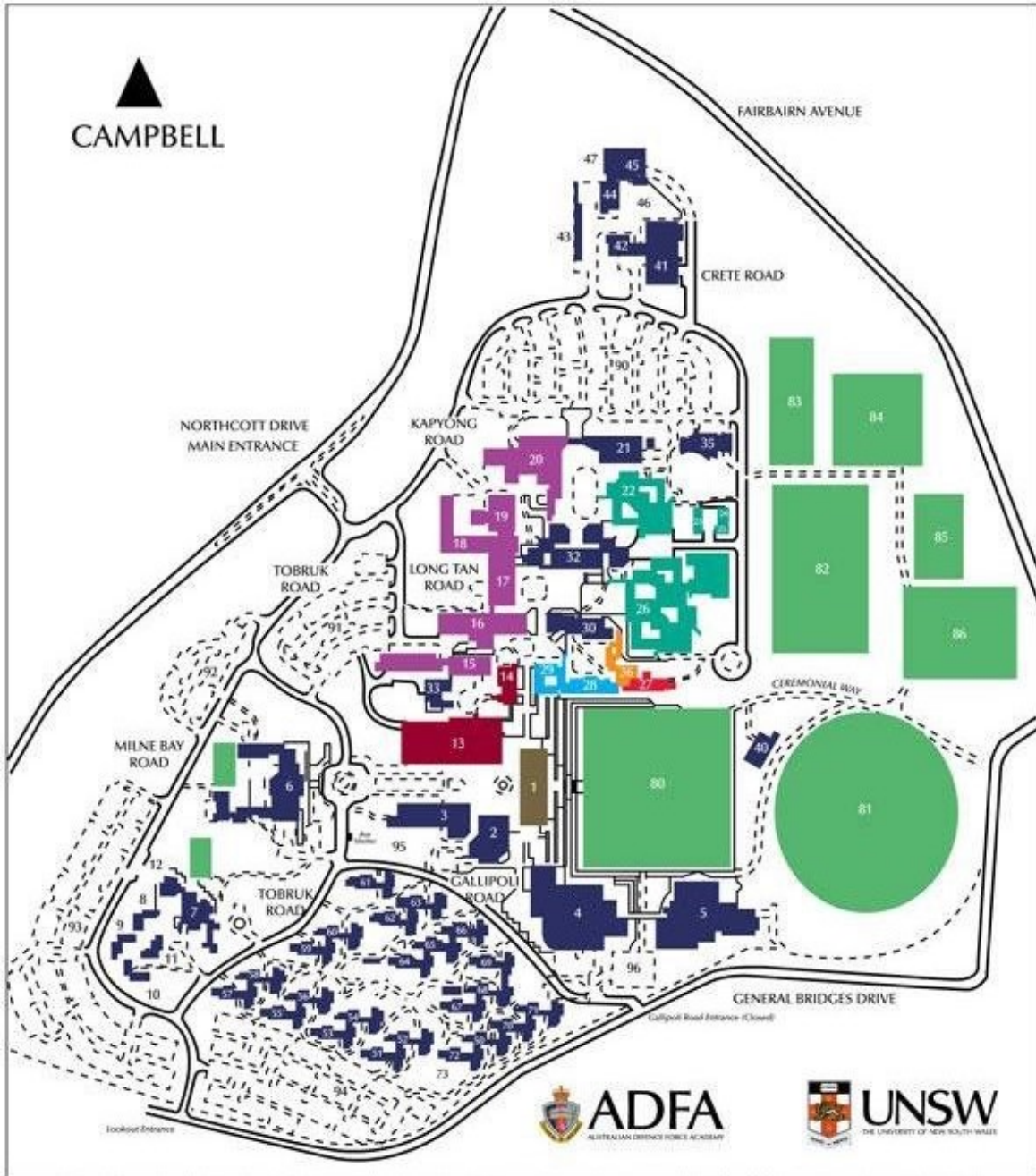
LT8 (24), **LT11** (24), **LT12** (60): flat-floored lecture theatres with rows of tables and chairs; single projector and screen.

SR3 (36), **SR4** (70), **SR5*** (45), **SR7*** (45): flat-floored seminar rooms with movable large tables and chairs, and plenty of space; single projector and screen.

*SR5 and SR7 have multiple TV monitors instead of a projector and screen.
